Those assessing children will assist you in the identification of special needs your child may have and in locating services to meet those needs. This screening is sponsored by the Flints Hills Special Education Cooperative and the Flint Hills Infant Toddler Network. The testing takes about forty-five minutes. Screenings will take place at Council Grove Elementary School in the morning. Screenings will be available at the Prairie Heights Elementary School in Dwight starting at 1:00 PM.
