LOCK UP YOUR LIQUOR!

One of the best ways to reduce teen alcohol use is to make sure your kids can't get alcohol



PROBLEM

- Using alcohol in the home without permission is a main source of initial alcohol use by teenagers
- Kids who drink with their parents are more likely to drink elsewhere as well
- Kids are more likely to drink if they believe their parents think drinking is okay
- Adults may be fined, arrested or sued for giving alcohol to people under age 21

SOLUTION

- ➔ Lock up or monitor alcohol use in your home
- ➔ Consider not serving alcohol to your own son or daughter
- ➔ Have clear family rules against under age drinking and enforce those rules
- ➔ Don't give or serve alcohol to teens that are not your own children

The holidays shouldn't be used as an excuse to bend the rules and break the law.
