

PDC Meeting 2/15/10

Kelly Gentry called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm. Those in attendance were Joe Glotzbach, Susan Graham, Candi Martin, Diane Miller, Marty White, Judeen Bachura.

The minutes were read and approved with the change that Candi Martin's plans that were approved are K-113 and K-114.

The first order of business was a request from Pam Smith to be granted some leave from the sick leave bank. Marty moved and Judeen seconded that we grant Pam Smith up to 8 sick leave days for treatment related to cancer. The motion passed 6-0.

Kelly reported that there is going to be a change of the professional development system in the state of Kansas. The federal government has a program called "Race to the Top". Kansas has applied for federal money from this program. One of the projects that the state used as part of this application involves changing professional development in Kansas. If the state gets this money, some of it will be filtered down to the districts. Even if the state does not get this money, the state is still going to redesign the professional development program. Kelly will keep us updated as she knows more.

Kelly presented the January DAC minutes.

Kelly talked about staff development for next year. Some of the topics that will be included are data work, topics determined by the buildings for MTSS, Math Expressions K-5, & superintendent priorities. If we get some grant money that we have applied for we will also include pieces of SAC for this summer, walkthroughs for administrators and teachers, study group for new evaluation instrument, & team to instructional coach institutes (level 1 information).
