For Parents:

- 1. **Be respectful to all volleyball officials, coaches**, **players**, **and parents**. If there is any sort of issue regarding the rules of the game, please **read the rule book first.** The game is constantly changing, so the rules may not be the same as the previous year.
- 2. If you need to talk to the **head coach** about a daughter's playing time:
 - The player must approach the coach and voice her concerns first.
 - The head coach recommends that a parent watch a week's worth of practices.
 - Absolutely <u>NO</u> confrontation on game nights will be allowed.
 - The head coach will accept phone calls, emails, or face-to-face conversations (after practices) 24 hours after the issue arises.
- 3. Parent involvement is welcome with fundraisers, tournaments, game nights, etc. If you have any ideas you'd like to share, please contact the head coach.
- Expect to have morning practices on Fridays: 6AM-7:30AM. The dates are: 8/30, 9/6, 9/13, 9/20, 9/27, 10/4, 10/11, 10/18.
- The coach has the right to adjust the volleyball line-up. A player's position is not secured at any point during the season. The coach welcomes competition and expects all players to work hard for their spots on the court.

For Players:

- 1. Take care of your bodies: eat properly, get enough rest, and drink plenty of water.
- 2. No drug or alcohol use will be tolerated. The head coach will follow the district's policy in regards to these offenses.
- 3. School comes first. If a player has a **D** or an **F** in any class, then she will work on homework at practices until the grade is raised.
- 4. **Respect all volleyball officials, players, parents, and coaches.** Respect your school and the opposing school's facilities as well.
- 5. If you **miss a practice or a game or are late to any volleyball related event**, there will be repercussions whether it is extra conditioning, a make-up practice, a game suspension, etc. The final decision will be made by the head coach.
- If you have any concerns volleyball related or not please feel free to approach the head coach before or after practices. My door will always be open.
- 7. Remember, if you are early then you are on time. When you are on time, you are LATE.
- 8. Keep <u>ALL</u> confrontation off the volleyball court.
