Results from August 2013

The PTA - The Power of Partnerships Family Survey was again made available for parents to complete at enrollment on July 31 and August 1, 2013. This was the second year they survey has been used to determine insight into family engagement.

71 surveys were completed by parents this year. The Prairie Heights Site Council members analyzed the results at the September meeting and developed a goal for the organization at the October meeting based on the survey results.

The positive points from parent survey responses were that communication between school and patrons had improved from the previous year, and they also indicated all students are challenged to do their best. The focus for improvement was communicating with patrons what powers are already shared and explore other opportunities. The Site Council wanted collaboration and involvement started last year between the Prairie Heights Schools and the communities be continued this year.
