## 2. Update on Kansas State Assessments

- a. Fiber-optic wire was mistakenly cut by KU construction. Shut down KITE testing for a day or so. The replacement wire was too small and could not handle the testing load - shut down KITE system for a couple of more days. (Kids and teachers have handled the testing uncertainty well.)
- b. CGES State Assessment progress All 3rd-6th grades have taken the MDPT in ELA and Math. Third grade is finished! Fourth grade ELA is finished. Fifth grade Science is finished. Sixth grade Social Studies is finished. (PTO will provide each 3rd-6th grade classroom with a end of testing celebration. Thank you PTO!)

## 3. New State reporting requirements for 2016-2017

At the PowerSchool training, it was announced that next year any student who missed more than 10% of the school year will be flagged in the PowerSchool system so the State has access to that information. (Discussed issues with PowerSchool on the parent side. Heather explained the recent migration, which has caused so bugs to be fixed in the system. Please continue to update the school when issues arise.)

All students will receive daily recesses, but if assignments are not turned in, areas of the playground will be restricted for play.
