ELECTION OF

BOE PRESIDENT

TinaRae Scott (Deidre Knight) nominated Terry Powell for USD 417 BOE President. Motion passed 6-0.

Marie Blythe joined the meeting via Zoom at 6:02 p.m.

<u>CONSENT</u>

- **AGENDA** TinaRae Scott (Scott Bankes) moved to approve the agenda and consent agenda as presented. Motion passed 7-0.
- **<u>REPORTS</u>** The board and administrators discussed memorializing Dennis DeLay, former CGHS principal and longtime community member, by naming the track after him; it was decided to discuss the matter in detail at a later meeting.

INFORMATION ITEMS

Superintendent Dody gave an overview of the FY2021 budget timeline.

Superintendent Dody updated the board on the progress made with the football field and track project, stating that the soil had recently been successfully stabilized.

Superintendent Dody updated the board on the secure entrances project, sharing that VHS Construction had submitted a bid he would recommend for approval. Dody also discussed how the delays incurred would affect construction at CGES.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Superintendent Dody informed the board that the official FHSEC special education assessment came in at about a \$12,000 increase over the previous year's assessment, which was much closer to Dody's estimate than the \$88,000 increase FHSEC initially projected.

Superintendent Dody expressed concern about the misinformation being shared in the community about COVID-19 and the district's plans for the upcoming school year. Dody said he and the administrators would be using draft guidance from the state to draft a local plan over the following few days for 2020-2021 school year operations.

Superintendent Dody reviewed KASB's June 2020 Recommended Policy updates and recommended them for approval at the next month's meeting.

Superintendent Dody and board members discussed maintenance on the exterior of the press box at Legion Stadium.

Superintendent Dody encouraged board members to consider moving the renewal date for administrator contracts to November or December to allow the existing board to extend contracts before new board members take office in January.

Superintendent Dody and board members discussed dates and locations for the annual goal setting meeting. The meeting was tentatively scheduled for October 12th, to immediately follow the regular board meeting, which would need to be moved to Monday the 10th.

Scott Bankes (Deidre Knight) nominated TinaRae Scott for USD 417 BOE Vice-President. Motion passed 7-0.

TinaRae Scott (Marie Blythe) moved to approved the Edgenuity site licenses. Motion passed 7-0.

TinaRae Scott (Deidre Knight) moved to accept the bid from John North Ford for a 10-passenger van for \$31,645. Motion passed 7-0.

TinaRae Scott (Scott Bankes) moved to accept the bids from BHS for the secure entrances projects at PHES and CGES. Motion passed 7-0.
