

CGES Bicycle Contract

Bicycles are permitted on campus only when used as a transportation device to and from school. Please note the following important factors:

- The privilege of bike riding is permitted as long as the rider exercises reasonable safety.
- At Council Grove Elementary School, independent (on their own) bicycle riding is limited to Students in grades 4-6. Students in grades K-3 may ride their bike when accompanied by a Parent or guardian to and from school.
- Provisions are made to safeguard bikes, but the school assumes no responsibility if a bicycle is Damaged or stolen. Students are encouraged to keep their bicycle locked at all times.

Repeated violations will mean students cannot ride their bicycle to school. The following rules are designed with student safety in mind, and documented violations can be cause for the loss of riding privileges.

- Students riding bicycles must wear bicycle helmets.
- Obey all traffic laws. Ride defensively-watch out for all traffic and people.
- Upon arrival on school grounds, dismount and walk your bike directly to the bike rack.
- When leaving the school, wait until all buses leave before approaching the bike rack by the bus Loading zone.
- Never ride your bike on the sidewalks at school or in the parking lot.
- Bicycles are not allowed in the classroom or school building.
- The school principal has the authority to not allow students to ride their bicycle to school for a Specified period of time.
