## Council Grove High School Mathematics Program Calculator CONTRACT

In order for students to be successful in Mathematics courses, it is at times necessary for all students to have access to a graphing calculator. Council Grove High School and the school district understands that graphing calculators are expensive and would like to ease the burden of additional expense to families by providing a "Calculator Check-Out System." *We still encourage students who are college bound to purchase their own if possible.* 

USD #417 will check out or loan one (1) TI Graphing Calculator to any student enrolled in a math class who does not wish to purchase his/her own graphing calculator.

The "loaned" calculator will be issued upon receipt of this contract signed by both the parent and student. Before signing, please be aware of the following...

- 1. The care and maintenance of the calculator is the responsibility of the student which includes the purchase of batteries should the batteries become low and need changing.
- 2. The student will bring the calculator to class each day. One (1) calculator is "loaned" for both classroom and homework use. Additional classroom sets are not available.
- 3. Should the graphing calculator "checked out" to the student become lost, stolen, broken, or damaged, the student will pay a \$100 replacement fee or buy a replacement calculator. **Work option:** The student may work for the replacement fee (minimum wage). Work will be assigned by the building administration, and the work will be performed before or after school.
- 4. Teachers may ask for calculators to be checked-in, inspected, and then reissued at different times throughout the semester or school year.
