Grades K-5 Core Resources and Assessments

English Language Arts (ELA)

K-2 Superkids (Zaner-Bloser) - new program 2022-2023; workbooks and hardback texts, online access plus teacher materials.

3-5 Into Reading (HMH) - new program 2022-2023; workbooks and hardback texts, online access plus teacher materials.

Handwriting – Zaner-Bloser handwriting. Grades K and 1 do not have separate handwriting workbooks; it is integrated into Superkids. Grades 2 through 6 do have separate handwriting workbooks. Grade 2 begins cursive. Students in grades 5th and 6th are expected to use cursive handwriting the entire year.

Math – Eureka Math (www.greatminds.org) Print materials available for each student plus online access for teacher.

Science – STEMscopes. Print materials available for each student plus teacher and student accounts online.

History-Government Social Studies – Themes for each grade level at www.usd417.net. Textbooks are resources – pacing guides do not have to reflect finishing the entire book as long as the standards and theme are covered. Grade 4 creates a Classroom Based assessment for state assessments.

Grades K-4 use “[HMH Social Studies 2012 hard back](#)” student books.

Grade 5 uses student write-in text: “[myWorld Interactive Social Studies \(2019\)](#)”. Digital accounts for teacher and students.

Grade levels may request a subscription to Studies Weekly magazine.

PE-Health – Curriculum on our website for PE. Classroom teachers also help teach Health in grades K-5. Choices magazine subscription for PE teacher to use.

Social Emotional Learning (K-6) – Second Step program. All materials online. Includes Bully Prevention and Child Protection units.
