

Nurse Reddick and Nurse Stecher will be completing hearing and vision screenings in the next few months. As a reminder, all students in grades PreK-3, 5, 7, and 10 will complete a vision and hearing screening. We also screen all new students, special education students and those who require an annual screening due to a failed hearing screening the year previous regardless of grade level. If you have any questions or concerns, please reach out to Nurse Reddick or Nurse Stecher.

As we dive deeper into the respiratory illness season, don't forget that we do have free Influenza and COVID testing available at school. We even have free home COVID tests that you can pick up from us at any time. Unfortunately, we do NOT have testing for Strep. This particular testing must be obtained from your primary care physician and sometimes is available at the local health department as well. We do not test without parent consent.

Medication Reminder: All meds must be brought to the health office in a properly labeled bottle by a parent for safety reasons and per policy. All medications require a parent consent for administration by school health staff. All prescription medications also require a doctor's signature. Please call, email (417nurse@cgrove417.org or rstecher@cgrove417.org), or stop by for the correct paperwork that must be signed prior to any medication administration at school.
