We celebrated a fun, successful music program in December. Many people helped to make it a great evening together. This month the 3rd through 6th grades will focus on note reading and using those skills to play the recorders. We are about halfway through the Music Memory program, learning about composers, their music and history. The young grades have some winter songs and interactive movement songs that we will enjoy together.

January PE Newsletter

During the month of January students will practice a variety of manipulative skills as well as working on communication/collaboration among their classmates. Students will practice skills such as dribbling/shooting a basketball, running in a mature pattern, utilizing rhythm, throwing/catching, utilizing defensive tactics such as a drop back step, defensive stances, and movement. These skills will be practiced in individual practice games, small sized games, and in a team game setting where students are encouraged to utilize strategic advantage in an offensive and defensive setting. Team building activities will be implemented within this month's curriculum to encourage problem solving, appropriate conflict resolution skills, collaboration among team members, and practice appropriate communication skills.

Kansas State Level Outcomes for each grade level that will be implemented within the PE curriculum include the following:

K-2nd:

- Applies corrective feedback to movement errors during performance. (2A.P2)
- Identifies physical activities that enhance health. (5A.EP1)

3rd-5th:

- Accepts responsibility if personal behavior affects others negatively. (4A.IM2)
- Executes basic offensive and defensive strategies and tactics used in a variety of activities, invasion games, net/wall games, throws, volleys, and striking. (2B.IM2)

6th:

- Performs defensive skills (i.e. drop step, defensive stance and movement) in modified and small-sided games. (1D.MS2)
- Creates or reduces space in invasion games through approach or retreat. (2B.MS2)



Parent/Guardian Notification: Dental Screenings

CareArc will be providing free dental screenings at Morris County Schools on February 1st, 2024. To comply with Kansas State Statute 72-5201, school children (K-12) should receive annual school-based dental screenings.

KDHE screenings identify the presence of decay, previous dental experience (fillings and/or sealants), infection, swelling, and pain. Parents are notified of the screening results, and those with dental treatment needs are referred to local dentists for care. School screenings are not a substitute for an examination by a dental professional, and it is recommended that all children have a dental home that provides regular, comprehensive dental care.

To participate in the screening, no action is required. If you would like your child to receive a fluoride varnish (in addition to the screening), please complete the top portion of the attached form. If you would like to opt your child out of the screening, please complete the bottom portion of the attached form. All students will be screened unless opted out.

** If your child sees a dentist regularly and receives fluoride applications, please do not sign them up for additional applications. Most dental insurances only cover a certain number of applications per year, and we do not want that to affect how they will cover your child at their regular dental visit.

Remember, that this is only a screening. Even if your child does see a dentist regularly, I would encourage them to go through the screening as well. It is completely up to you, though.

Each child will be screened unless opted out ahead of time by a parent signature.
