Summary of KASB data

- 1. Morris County hit our peak population in 1910. Since then the county has had a declining population.
- 2. Unless something significant happens, there is no reason to believe this trend will reverse.
- 3. The enrollment at Morris County Schools has been declining for many years. Though there are years where the enrollment will increase, the trend line is down.
- 4. Our student population is more mobile than it has been in the past with almost a quarter of our students turning over on a regular basis.
- 5. The district tends to see a portion of 8th grade students from PHMS not enroll at CGHS.
- 6. PH schools has a declining enrollment trend.
- 7. CGHS will see a significant decline in student enrollment in the coming years. Its overall trend line is down as well.
