- 2. MTSS Update Angela Harris and Krista Wilson
 - a. 2nd/3rd Grade Reading Interventions
 - i. Restructured Title to where this year 1.5 FTE were at CGES and the .5 was split between CGHSJS and PHES.
 - ii. Screening all students. We screened 7-12 using Fast Bridge, and all schools will be switching to it next year.
 - iii. All students will be tested using Fast Bridge instead of AIMS Web Plus.
 - iv. We incorporated a new program for interventions called HD Word.
 - v. After using the new program with the second grade and third grade from the beginning of the school year to April many students moved up to being closer or on grade level. They have made tremendous progress.
 - vi. Next steps
 - 1. Update intervention protocols for Math and Reading
 - 2. Implement Fast Bridge instead of Aims Web
 - 3. Continue implementation and refinement of intervention system at CGJSHS
 - 4. Create and implement systematic intervention plan for Math
- 3. CGES Family Engagement Policy Draft
 - a. Input/Feedback from PAC
