2. Data
 - a. Olweus Survey Data (Heather presented a brief summary of results from the Olweus Survey that was given to 3rd-6th graders in October. Students still are having a hard time understanding the difference between being rude, mean or annoying and bullying. Olweus said this is typical to see this in the first few years the survey is administered. This is the 3rd year of giving the survey. Discussed the survey and looked over graphs and data collected from the survey.)

 - a. Getting prepared for State Assessment Testing (more info @ Feb. Site Council Meeting) (Heather will go into a more detailed report at our February meeting. Explained just some of the preparations to be able to start testing - training, updating all computers, and scheduling.)
